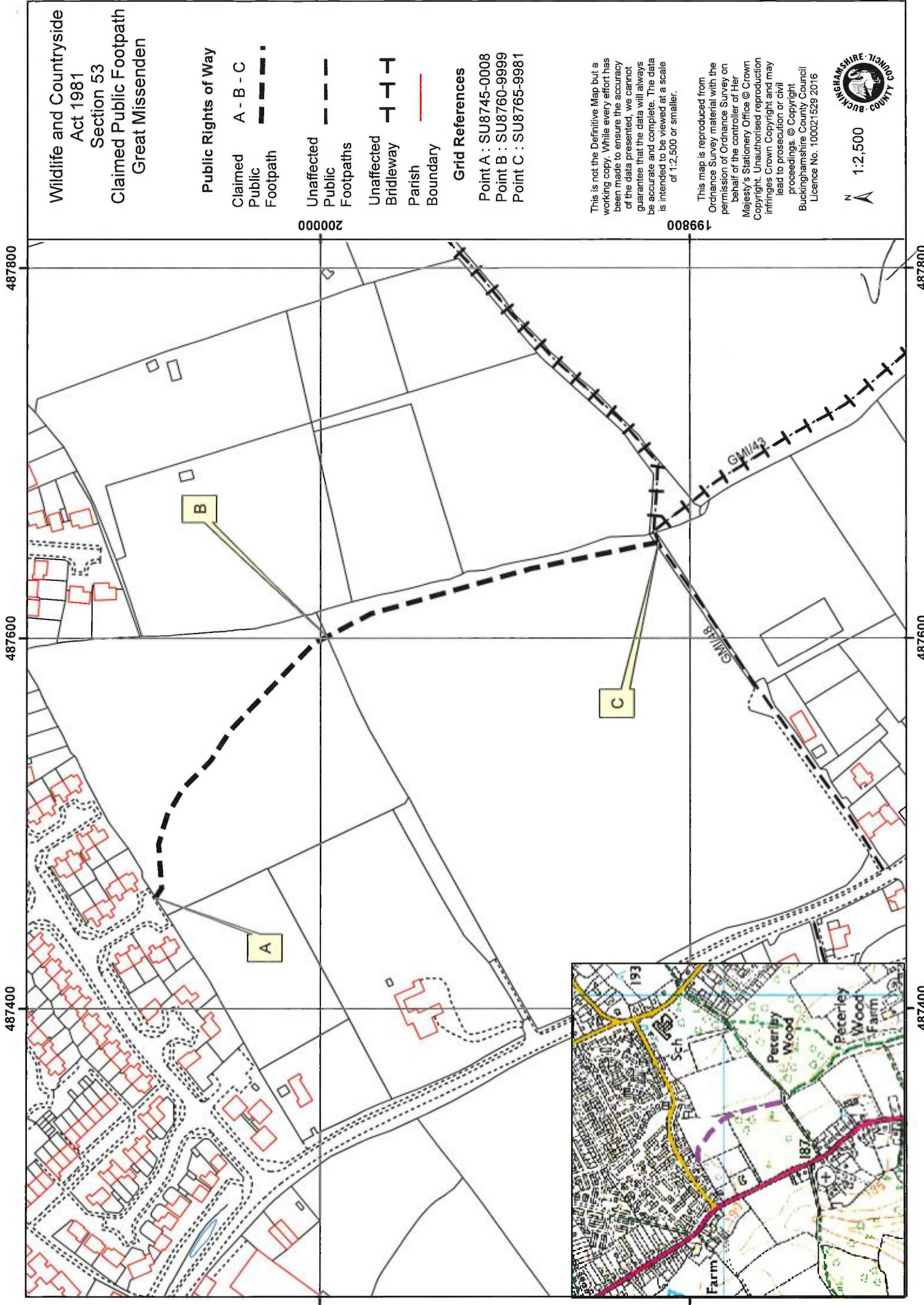

(PARISH OF GREAT MISSENDEN)
DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2016**

This Order is made by Buckinghamshire County Council (“the Authority”) under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the Act”) because it appears to that authority that the Buckinghamshire County Council Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of an occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(b) namely, the expiration, in relation to any way in the area to which the map relates, of any period such that the enjoyment by the public of the way during that period raises a presumption that the way has been dedicated as a public path or restricted byway.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Buckinghamshire County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is the First day of August 2016.
2. The Buckinghamshire County Council Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the The Buckinghamshire County Council (Parish of Great Missenden) Definitive Map Modification Order 2016.

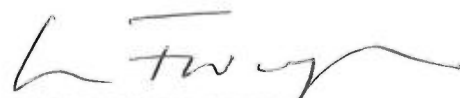
